Thank you for choosing our school to begin your child's primary learning journey. Please find below the details of your child's first days in Reception.

What will happen on your child's first day?

From Wednesday 4th September please bring your child to the large playground by the Reception classroom doors at 8:40am where members of the Reception Team will greet you and then lead the children into the Reception class. If your child is upset please be brave and hand him/her over to staff. If you would like to reassure yourself that they have settled well, please feel free to phone the office later in the morning. Staff will be happy to check your child and put your mind at rest.

When collecting, please wait outside the Reception classroom exit doors on the large playground, where your child will only be released to named persons. Please ensure you have completed the 'contact form' as it will inform us who may collect your child.

Lunch Options

Children may bring in a packed lunch from home in a clearly labelled lunch box or lunch bag showing both your child's name and class. Upshire School is a 'Healthy School' so we encourage healthy packed lunch options. Fizzy drinks are not allowed. We are also a nut free school.

As an alternative to a home packed lunch we can provide a healthy school dinner free of charge until the end of Key Stage 1. A sample menu is available on the school website. We will send menus home each half term for you to discuss with your child and choose their meals together. We then ask you to return these to school in your children's book bags.

Upshire School operates a healthy snack policy and we offer all reception children fresh fruit or vegetables at snack time each day. We ask that children bring in a named water bottle, which will be returned home with your child at the end of each day. Free milk is also provided for the under-fives. To ensure your child receives their free milk, please complete the form (which will be given out at the transition meeting) and return these to the address indicated on the form. Once your child turns five, if you would still like them to receive milk, this can be paid for on the coolmilk website. In addition, the school offers toast at breaktime for a small charge of 25p a day or £1.25 a week. All payments should be made via Parentmail.

After school is the best time for an informal chat where staff will endeavor to help with any problems and prevent them from escalating. If you would like to speak at length, or discuss any private matters, please make an appointment via the school office.
